Riverside Grads Give Back by Giving Backpacks

A few years ago, four precocious Riverside High School graduates put an ambitious idea into action for the good of our community. We spoke with Matt Parsons, President of The Backpack Fund, about the project, and how it has been helping young people here in Lake County in meaningful ways.

What is the principal mission of The Backpack Fund?

"The purpose of The Backpack Fund is to ensure that every student in Lake County has access to the school supplies and scholarships they need to pursue their dreams through community support for each other."

How did you and your partners get started with the project?

"The Backpack Fund was started in 2020 by four 2018 Riverside graduates. This was at the start of the COVID pandemic, and it was a time that people really benefited from some extra support. We were a bunch of kids, and The Backpack Fund was our dream. The success that we've had is proof for all kids that their dreams are possible too."

In what ways have the backpack-and-schoolsupply giveaways helped the community?

"The Backpack Supply Drops have had an immense impact on the community. In two years, we have donated over 1,200 backpacks and school supplies. Some people just see the backpacks as they are, but to us, the backpacks are representative of how much the community believes is the next generation of students. All of the work that goes into the Supply Drop event shows how much we believe in kids as a community. Every year, we receive countless "thank yous" from the families receiving the supplies. The Supply Drops are emotional days

filled with excitement, laughter, and gratitude."

How have your scholarships helped Riverside graduates?

"The Emily Ringler Memorial Scholarship has gone a long way towards making a difference for local kids. We've now awarded three \$1,000 scholarships. The scholarships make pursuing higher education possible for our recipients. It directly awards them the scholarship to use as they need. The 2021 recipient, Gabrielle Fender, used the scholarship to get a computer that she used every day at school. She will feel the impact of the scholarship throughout her education."

How can our local community support your requisite work?

"The best ways to support The Backpack Fund are to donate on our website,

thebackpackfundohio.com, or by sharing the project. We are on all major social media platforms @thebackpackfund. We have hosted raffles and giveaways throughout our history to give back to donors. We also have a business sponsorship program to give back to businesses that support us. We are also a 501(c)(3) nonprofit, so any donations made to The Backpack Fund are tax deductible."

What does the future hold for The Backpack Fund?

"From the very beginning, we committed to always offering the Emily Ringler Memorial



Scholarship. She is an important member of The Backpack Fund family, and we want her memory to live on forever. We also have many new ideas that we want to pursue in the future. We want to launch additional scholarships. With increased fundraising, we can offer additional scholarships to support local students. A step further down the line for us would be launching Community Engaged Learning grants that local teachers can apply for to complete real world projects in the community. These projects would engage the school, students, and a community partner to jointly complete projects that benefit the community."
